



Counting out 8 items (math concepts).

- Spring is a season of the year.
- Tulips, daffodils, cherry blossoms are all spring flowers
- Flowers bloom in the spring (because the weather is getting warmer)
- Spring planting concepts: clean and dirty, windy, rainy, and heavy.
- Plants start as seeds and bulbs.
- The parts of plants: stem, flower, trunk, leaves,
- Plants need things to grow: dirt, sunshine and water/rain
- Actions like, : digging patting, planting, watering...
- We learn to be patient as we wait and watch for our plants to grow
