

Some are Clothing and some are NOT!



Use to test/teach the category name CLOTHING/NOT CLOTHING.

Year 2: Model first. "Some of these things are CLOTHES and some are NOT CLOTHES." Point to the hat. "Is a hat clothing? (Yes). You can wear it so it's clothing." Point to the sheep. "How about a sheep? Is a sheep clothing? (NO). Of course not. A sheep is a \_\_\_\_ (farm animal)." Repeat with the remaining pictures. Next, have the children answer with only support from you. Test by having an individual child answer 2-3 items.

Challenge tasks: "When do you wear mittens?" (in the winter). "Here's a hat. Tell me about this hat" (It's pink. You wear it on your head. It keeps you warm...). "What do you wear when it's cold outside? (gloves, scarf, boots...)." "Here's a sheep. Have you ever seen a sheep?" (Yes) "Tell me about a sheep" (it lives on a farm, it's soft, it says 'baaaa,' it gives wool...).
