

These shirts have different kinds of sleeves! Some are LONG. Some are NOT LONG.



Use to test or teach LONG/NOT LONG or LONG/SHORT.

LONG/NOT LONG: "Here are some shirts for our Ducks. Go Ducks! Look!" Point to each shirt from left to right. Be expressive when you say, "LONG sleeves. See, they go all the way down. NOT LONG. NOT LONG. LONG sleeves. Your turn. Tell me LONG or NOT LONG."

LONG/SHORT (assumes child already knows LONG): "Here are some shirts for our Ducks. Go Ducks! Look!" Point to each shirt from left to right. Be expressive when you say, "LONG sleeves. NOT LONG. That's called SHORT. SHORT again. LONG sleeves. Your turn. Tell me LONG or SHORT."

Be sure to have real shirts available for further teaching or testing and/or manding. Use ones you've brought or ones you/children are wearing.
